- Back up your files in Google Drive
- Use Google Drive app to access your files on the go
- Open and Edit various kinds of documents in Google Drive

Are you using a computer that doesn't have the software you need to open a certain kind of file? Don't fret – upload it to your Google Drive account and open it from there. Google Drive allows you to open anything from Adobe Suite files, to spreadsheets and Microsoft Word documents.

- Easy password reset

It is important to keep your account secure but we all forget a password sometimes. In order to be able to reset your own password, make sure you have added a recovery email or phone number to your account.

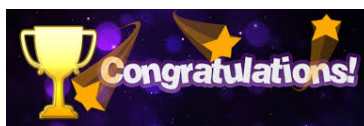

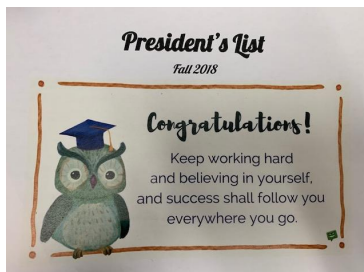
